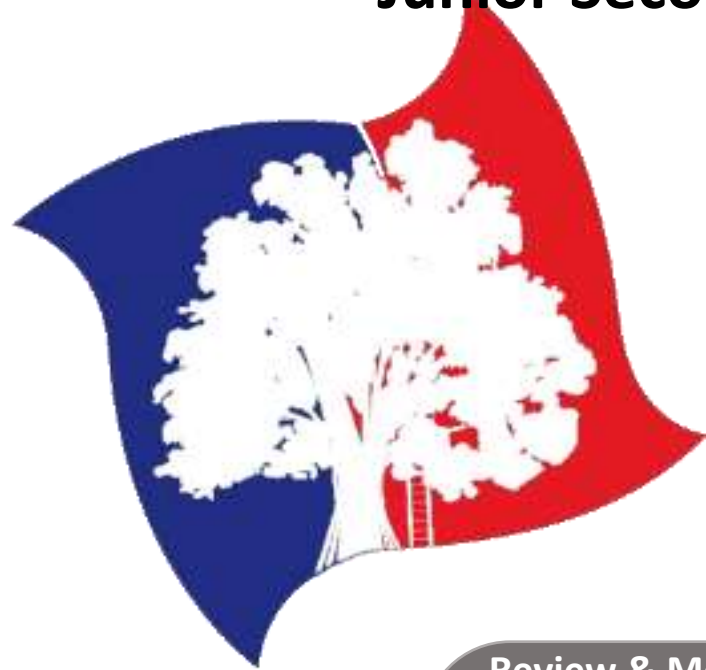

Junior Secondary School

The vision of our Junior Secondary School at Nursery Road is to provide an adolescent focused bridge between primary and secondary school years which is age and developmentally appropriate for all students. Students access the Australian Curriculum through whole class and individually developed curriculum plans. This includes English, Math, Health and Physical Education, Music and Environmental Studies. Underpinning all of our students' learning is the focus on developing effective communication skills and Personal and Social Capabilities; the skills required for our learners to be actively and appropriately engaged in valuable experiences at school and in the community. The development of teamwork and relationship skills are a key part of our learners' experiences, both embedded throughout the day and explicitly during activities such as the Duke of Edinburgh Bridge award, school camp, working alongside visiting students and student selected special interest clubs.
