Junior School

The vision of our Junior School at Nursery Road is to provide an age related learning environment for students to develop the early skills required for literacy and numeracy. Early literacy, numeracy and communication skills are the primary focus in the Junior School. Students are provided with the key tools specific to their individual needs to engage in communication and early literacy learning. Rich Communication environments are central to the Junior School. Familiar routines and transitions are developed and embedded in everyday learning to promote the development of the independence skills required to be active learners.
